Mount the shock, referencing your authorized shop manual, noting the following important details: Make sure the rebound adjustment is at the bottom facing the left side of the motorcycle and the pressure valve is facing the rear tire. Tighten shock bolts to the proper torque specifications (*refer to your manual*).

Caution: The installed spring length must never be set shorter than 5.25" for the Std. Length (465-1148) or 4.62" for the 1" Lowered (465-1149) or shock damage may occur.
