- 1. Shouldered sleeves with O-rings should already be installed in the shock eye. If not, insert sleeves with O-rings in the top eye (see figure 1).
- 2. Mount the shock, referencing your authorized shop manual, noting the following important details: Make sure the rebound adjuster is at the bottom facing the right hand side of the motorcycle and the pressure valve is facing towards the rear wheel . Tighten shock bolts to the proper torque specifications (refer to authorized shop manual).

Caution: The installed spring length must never be set shorter than 5.25" or shock damage may occur.
